
At CEFAM, undergraduates can earn dual degrees in four years (or even triple degrees in five). Spend 3 years on our campus in Lyon and 1 year either in the United States or 2 years in Canada at one of our partner universities. You can also choose to remain at CEFAM all four years.




CEFAM's dual degree programs invite students into an international environment with multinational faculty who bring real-world experience directly into the classroom.

Business Track

CEFAM's academic program is based on the American and Canadian models in liberal arts education. In order to earn dual degrees, students spend their first 3 years on CEFAM's campus in Lyon, and their final year in a US or a Canadian partner university. They then graduate with both a French and an American or Canadian degree. The French degree (RNCP level 7 "Manager of International Organizations") and the US degree is a Bachelor's of Business Administration in any Business major available at the partner university. The Canadian degree is a Master of Business Administration.


3 Years to Learn the Fundamentals

The first 3 years of the program are dedicated to developing students' knowledge in Business and general education courses, as well as professional competencies through the completion of two internships.

1 or 2 Years of Specialization

After 3 years in Lyon, CEFAM students go on to choose their major in the following year. They have 3 options:

- Spend 1 year studying in the United States at one of our 6 partner universities and earn a BBA as the second degree
- Spend 1 year studying in Canada at University of New Brunswick and earn an MBA as the second degree
- Continue at **CEFAM** for their 4th year and earn a MSc in Marketing or Finance.



Application process for 1st year and transfer students



- 1. Fill out the online application at cefam.fr/en and upload requested documents.
- 2. Pay the entrance exam fee of 140€.
- 3. Complete the entrance exam online, including Admissions Interview.

Note to transfer students: You may send transcripts in advance for evaluation. Accumulation of credits matching the CEFAM program will determine at which level a transfer student enrolls.
